

MINOR IN BIOLOGY – 22 HOURS

All course in Biology and supportive courses must be completed with a minimum grade of C or higher.

Note: In order to fulfill the 25% minor residency requirement, at least six (6) credit hours of biology minor coursework must be completed at UNM.

1: Complete the four-course introductory sequence:

BIOL 202L	Genetics	4	Prerequisites: CHEM 121 & 123L and BIOL 201L <i>Pre or Co-requisite:</i> CHEM 122 & 124L
BIOL 303 & 303L	Ecology & Evolution	4 (3/1)	Prerequisites: BIOL 202L <i>Pre or Co-requisite:</i> MATH 180 (or MATH 162)
BIOL 304 & 304L	Plant & Animal Form & Function	4 (3/1)	Prerequisites: CHEM 122 (or 132) & 124L, BIOL 303 & 303L <i>Pre or Co-requisite:</i> MATH 180 (or MATH 162)

2: Complete additional biology minor elective courses so that the total number of biology hours totals at least 22.

Courses	Credit hours

The following courses **cannot** be applied toward biology minor elective hours: BIOL 110, BIOL 112L, BIOL 123, BIOL 124L, BIOL 223, BIOL 224, BIOL 225, BIOL 239L, and BIOL 499.

Up to 2 credit hours of BIOL 402 may be applied toward the biology minor.

Up to 4 credit hours of BIOL 400 may be applied toward the biology minor.

BIOL 423 may be used toward the biology elective hours **ONLY** if it is not being used toward the major or minor in chemistry.
